

from our commercial kitchen as our Director also has 30 years of experience as a professional photographer. Streaming not only permits social distancing but also helps you reach a larger audience and even a pay-per-view one.



### Costs

There is a fee for both the kitchen rental and the live video streaming service. You may choose to:



- 1. pay for both outright and either allow your viewers to watch for free or have them pay-per-view using your own credit card processing service.
- 2. skip the rental and divide the pay-per-view income with us. We would take online payments from your viewers using our PayPal account and divide the income with you. This offer is a business incubator service. Not available to all clients.

## **Output**

- Streaming can be broadcast to Zoom, Skype, Facebook, etc. They can be your accounts or ours.
- Streaming can be recorded for later use with or without editing for use on your website, YouTube, etc.

## Personal Protection

- 1. You may have your own lavalier microphone (one that attaches to your collar) so that you can move about the kitchen as the live video is streaming.
- 2. The video camera could be stationery and the photographer outside of the kitchen.
- 3. The video camera could zoom in out and move right and left, with the photographer operating it from at least 6' away.
- 4. You would need to leave the kitchen in the state that you found it and our cleaning service would do additional disinfecting.
- 5. You could arrange to use the kitchen several days after the last renter.
